WHO WE ARE:

Catholic Mission Trips, Inc is a non-profit 501(c)3 activating Catholics in the call to be missionary disciples. We offer short term foreign and domestic mission trips for youth groups, college students, and families to serve the poor and rebuild communities in need.



SERVICE-ORIENTED

We respond to the specific needs of communities both domestic and internationally, focusing on the Corporal Works of Mercy, including disaster relief, building projects for the poor, feeding the homeless, community outreach for the elderly and visiting orphaned children.

LOCATIONS

- **Dominican Republic** Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos, school and orphanage in San Pedro de Macoris, construction projects for the school and surrounding community.
- **Belize** Serving with the Jesuit priest community in Punta Gorda and the Pallotine sisters, construction projects for families in need from the surrounding villages.
- **Puerto Rico** Serving with the lay Missionary Community of Villaregia "ad gentes" in Arecibo, construction projects for families surviving Hurricane Maria & recent earthquakes.
- **South Texas** The heart of CMT, serving refugees on the border with Catholic Charities, construction projects for the poor.

- **New Orleans** Rebuilding homes for low-income families and elderly folks surviving hurricanes of NOLA.
- **New Mexico** Diocese of Gallup, construction, renovation, and outreach projects throughout the diocese and with Native American communities.
- **Panama City** Restoring homes for victims of Hurricane Michael of 2018 in the panhandle of Florida.
- **Houston** Construction projects for families surviving Gulf Coast hurricane damage.
- **Kentucky** Serving in the rural Appalachian mountains, one of the poorest places in the U.S. construction projects for the poor.
